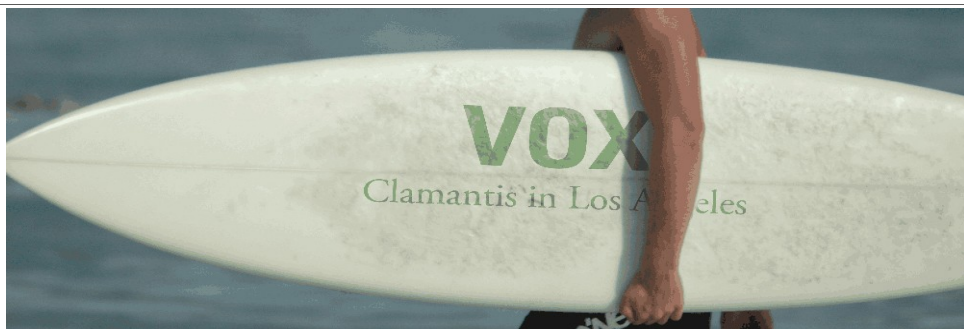

Established in 1986, Baily Vineyard and Winery specializes in wines made from Bordeaux varieties. Baily wines have won gold medals at all of the major wine competitions in the state, including the California State Fair, the Los Angeles County Fair, the Orange County Fair, and the San Francisco Wine Competition.

On September 12th Phil Baily '62 will start off our day by giving us an exclusive tour of his winery and discussing his experiences in the wine business. Afterward, he will lead a tasting of his wines. A buffet-style lunch will follow at his wife's restaurant, Carol's.

DCLA Board member David Eichman '82 is working very hard on the planning committee for the next all class reunion for the Dartmouth Gay, Lesbian, Bisexual and Transgender Alumni/ae Association which will take place in Hanover October 30 - November 1, 2009. The Right Reverend V. Gene Robinson, Episcopal Bishop of New Hampshire has been confirmed as a speaker. There will be a lot of time to meet other LGBT alums as well as President Jim Kim and many other professors and staff. Professor Peter Saccio will give one of his fabulous lectures. There is a tour of the gender neutral dorm planned as well as a gala awards dinner on Saturday night. DGALA is celebrating its 25th anniversary! Please visit www.dgala.org.

THE DARTMOUTH ENTREPRENEURIAL NETWORK is in Los Angeles – Are you interested in being a part of it? Brainchild of Dartmouth professor Gregg Fairbrothers D'76, the Dartmouth Entrepreneurial Network was first started in 2000 with the mission of supporting Dartmouth entrepreneurs. Since then the DEN has helped hundreds of people through public lectures, Greener Ventures conferences, and other networking opportunities. Today the DEN community includes active groups not only in Hanover, but also in New York, Boston, Seattle, and as of 2009, Los Angeles. While sharing common ties with Hanover and other cities, DEN LA brings together alumni based in Southern California from Dartmouth, Thayer, Tuck and the Medical School who are interested in entrepreneurship. Our goal is to create a safe networking environment for aspiring and seasoned entrepreneurs, investors, and service providers, and to foster strong community building, and mentorship.



Our major event this year was selecting and submitting an entry into the DEN Business Plan Competition. Our entry was NuBorn Beverages, an LA startup that is marketing drinks made with mixtures of teas, juices, and spices. Nuborn was a finalist in the competition, but was beat out for the \$50,000 prize by Novoculi, which is developing a non-invasive device for diabetics to test their blood sugar.

Our other big event has been a visit to the manufacturing facilities of Space Exploration Technologies or Space-X. Space-X was founded in 2002 by Elon Musk, (also the co-founder of PayPal, and Tesla motors), in order to radically reduce the cost of access to space by staking an economical approach to the design philosophy. Since its inception, the company has achieved one successful orbital launch and has been awarded over one billion dollars of contracts by NASA, DoD and private organizations. DEN LA visitors saw the construction and assembly of rocket and spacecraft components including engines, structures, avionics and the orbital Dragon spacecraft, all under the roof of one of the largest buildings in LA.

Gary Schwartz, one of the world's top three experts on Rembrandt, was flown in from The Netherlands for our event and gave us

an engaging lecture on the artist's life. Michael Schwartz, the owner of the gallery, presided over the evening's activities, especially the excitement of the auction and the raffle of three museum quality works of art. Craig Douglass '78 and his wife Julie were the lucky winners of two of the raffle pieces including the Rembrandt shown to the right. Over one hundred works of museum quality art were auctioned including: Rembrandt, Van Rijn, Marc Chagall, Joan Miro, Toulouse Lautrec, Pierre Auguste Renoir, Salvador Dali, and Pablo Picasso.
